'Sacramentum' meant an oath or a pledge of fidelity.

Definition in Adult Catechism on p. 169.

Another definition: Sacraments are "visible signs of God's saving love. (CCC #773)

Sacraments involve visible and invisible elements.

Jesus Christ is at work in the sacraments. Through the sacraments, Jesus Christ provides grace.

Consider sign symbol event/encounter

We encounter God more often than we might think..IF..we are paying attention. This shapes our spirituality.

We encounter God in events and aspects of everyday life.

- We encounter God in the person of Jesus.
- We encounter Jesus through the CHURCH.
- The world encounters the Church through US.
