missal - "missa" is Latin for "Mass". This book holds readings for Mass.
Eucharist - Greek word for thanksgiving. Eucharist also means Holy Communion. The eucharistic celebration is the Mass, particularly the second half.

Sacrament - Connection to God's grace.

Grace is God's constant invitation to relationship.

Worship and ritual.

Mass is the "source and summit of our faith." (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 1963) Liturgy is the public work of the Church.

Lex orandi, lex credendi. What we pray is what we believe.

"Equally important for a correct ars celebrandi is an attentiveness to the various kinds of language that the liturgy employs: words and music, gestures and silence, movement, the liturgical colors of the vestments. By its very nature the liturgy operates on different levels of communication which enable it to engage the whole human person." (Pope Benedict XIV, Sacramentum Caritatis, no. 40)

Conscious, active, and full participation in order to obtain the fullest measure of grace. (efficacy) We are not to be spectators.

LITURGY OF THE WORD (Gather 172)

On Sunday Mass, first reading is from Hebrew scriptures. "Thanks be to God."

Psalm (also from the Hebrew scriptures) to be sung or said.

Second reading from the letters of Paul or other apostolic writing. "Thanks be to God."

Gospel reading (Gather 173) (stand)

Alleluia (Latin; Hallelujah is Hebrew) - (stand) During Lent "Praise and honor to you, O Lord Jesus Christ."

"The Lord be with you." "And with your spirit." "A reading according to the holy Gospel of ____." "Glory to you, O Lord." **Sign**

"The gospel of the Lord." Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ."
