

How to Ring the Bell at Consecration

The first ring is a short but loud ring when the priest turns his palms down above the gifts to call down the Holy Spirit (Epiclesis). It is a short and loud ring that should be heard throughout the church, but without sounding it too long which will overpower the Priest's prayer (Preface).

Then, as the bread and later the wine are elevated, do **3 SHORT RINGS WITH A SHORT PAUSE BETWEEN THEM. See the video below on YouTube for how it should sound.**

Please don't be shy ringing the bells and let them ring out before you place them back on the floor.
